

Agreement between the 'HUMAN-Stiftung' and the Creation India Society (CIS)



The founders of the 'HUMAN Stiftung', Edith and Karlheinz Neumann, visited the Creation India Society (CIS) in April 2015. They made the acquaintance of the CIS founder Dr. Satya Prakash in Varanasi/India and were made aware, in detail, of the CIS projects managed by the Society. CIS was registered on December 31st, 2004 according to Societies Registration Act 1860 and the registration number is 1187. CIS was founded on January 7th, 2003 by Dr. Satya Prakash and his wife, Mrs. Mala.

The main activities of CIS, amongst other things, are in these three areas:

1. The organization attempts to remove social evils such as injustice to women, dowry system, untouchables, drug addiction, unemployment, political and social crime.
2. Through its established centers the organization will actively advocate social development for orphans, street children, handicapped children and youths.
3. The organization will try to improve the welfare and rights of the less fortunate people in rural areas like farmers, helpless people, underdogs, minorities, women and children.

The 'HUMAN-Stiftung' was founded in Germany on December 12th, 2014 and is approved as a non-profit and charitable organization by the tax office Neuss in North Rhine Westphalia. After intensive discussions, the board members of the HUMAN foundation decided to run accurately defined projects of the CIS and to constantly support CIS. The aims of CIS and the 'HUMAN Foundation' are in many areas consistent.

General Agreement

The CIS acts according to the general agreement with the 'HUMAN-Stiftung' and will use the financial funds only in accordance with the general agreement with the 'HUMAN Stiftung'. In order to establish the highest possible transparency of cooperation between the two parties the following basic principles will be defined:

1. All conditions are based on the agreement between the 'HUMAN-Stiftung' and CIS, represented by Dr. Satya Prakash, founder of CIS.
2. In order to substantiate the financial funds of the 'HUMAN-Stiftung', an annual project plan with a detailed project profile will be developed.
3. CIS, represented by Dr. Satya Prakash will bi-annually send a short report of the progress of the projects to the board of the 'HUMAN-Stiftung'.
4. CIS has to provide valid proof of cash flow to the beneficiaries of the financial funds.

5. A member of the board of the 'HUMAN-Stiftung' will make occasional onsite visits to Varanasi and Robertsganj and report on the CIS activities.
6. All payments to CIS by the 'HUMAN-Stiftung' will be carried out in accordance to the FCRA registration from March 1st, 2013 (FCRA number 136760210) of the 'Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs' (Bank Account of the Creation India Society at 'State Bank of India, Sarnath/Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, account number 30961715128, Swift Code SBINNBB125, IFSC Code SBIN0004560').

These basic principles of the cooperation are valid indefinitely until the termination of or any change in the 'HUMAN Foundation'. This agreement will be signed by the board of the 'HUMAN Foundation' and Dr. Satya Prakash, founder of CIS.

Project-Agreement between 'HUMAN-Stiftung' and the Creation India Society (CIS) for the year 2016

For 2016 the 'HUMAN-Stiftung' is going to support the following projects:

Support of deprived children



In the **Keshwa Child Welfare Center** in Robertsganj, the CIS offers care for children from particular deprived and poor backgrounds.

Robertsganj is a city in the north Indian state Uttar Pradesh around 90 km from Varanasi in the south-east of Uttar Pradesh and the northern edge of Kaimur Mountain. Robertsganj has about 30.000 inhabitants.

Robertsganj is the Center of Administration of the Sonbhadra district. The literacy rate (64 percent) is low in this district and is even below the already low average level in Uttar Pradesh (68 percent). The location of the CIS care center is in the village Badhauli, Gorari Road.

Only a few of the children in CIS's care are attending school but we want to change that. With our funds about 20 children, girls and boys aged between 4 and 15 years, will receive support. Some of the children originate from a caste, which people are cut from the mainstream society. The kids can come anytime to the center for education in social matters, health issues, hygienic measures, get – if necessary – medical support and will be able to create their own recreational activities in the group together with the carers.



Extremely important for us is the support and taking care of handicapped children and at least 2-3 orphans. Overall objective is to try and give these specifically deprived children at least a chance to catch up with the mainstream society through encouragement and motivation.

One particular part of this project is aiming at educating and supporting the immediate relatives (parents, elder siblings, etc.,) in earning their living for the future. This measure should help to avoid child labor and create a child-oriented atmosphere in their families.



The manager of this institution is Mrs. Bhawani Agarwal. She will be supported by 2-3 carers. Dr. Satya Prakash will visit **Keshwa Child Welfare Center** 4-5 times per month.

The 'HUMAN Foundation' specifically takes responsibility in 2016 in the following areas. All cost items are calculated on a monthly basis.

Staff and accommodation:

- 1. Rent, electricity etc.: Rs. 7,000
- 2. Staff expenses (3-4 full time): Rs.13,000

Activities:

- 1. Education material Rs. 6,400
- 2. Medical support Rs. 4,000
- 3. Recreation activities Rs. 2,000
- 4. Adult education for relatives Rs. 1,500

The monthly fees add up to about Rs. 34,000. On an annual basis the total expenses result in about Rs. 410,000.

In total we are planning to raise up to Rs. 500,000 (five hundred thousand Rupees), for the CIS/HUMAN project. In case of additional support being required, any change in the agreement will need to be agreed upon separately and will be dependent on the 'HUMAN-Stiftung' current donations and income.



The project execution in 2016 occurs according to the general agreement of March 2016. CIS will provide reports and copies of payment documents to the 'HUMAN-Stiftung'.
