<p style="text-align: center;">Transfer / Standing Order</p>	<p>For citizens of the Federal Republic of Germany:</p> <p>No donation receipts are issued for donations up to € 199. Here the tax office suffices with the deposit slip at your bank or a printout with online banking.</p> <p>For donations >€ 200, you will automatically receive donation receipts. To do this, you must provide your full address when making the first transfer so that the address can be saved for this purpose.</p> <p>If you have forgotten this, please send us a message with your full address.</p> <p>If your address changes, please be sure to provide your new address.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">PayPal</p>	<p>For citizens of the Federal Republic of Germany:</p> <p>No donation certificates are issued for donations up to € 199. The deposit receipt at PayPal is sufficient for the tax office.</p> <p>For donations > € 200 or for recurring payments with PayPal, please pass on your full address details.</p> <p>If your address changes, please be sure to provide your new address.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">GlobalGiving</p>	<p>For citizens of the Federal Republic of Germany:</p> <p>Donations via GlobalGiving up to € 199 are recognized by the tax office. Please print out the confirmation that GlobalGiving will send you.</p> <p>Donations > € 200 are not tax beneficial, since GlobalGiving cannot issue explicit donation receipts that are recognized in Germany.</p> <p>Full tax benefits apply to US and UK citizens in accordance with GlobalGiving's terms & conditions.</p>
